About the INTO LIGHT Project

The INTO LIGHT Project is a national nonprofit working to help people better understand addiction. We share the stories of those who have died from substance use disorder through hand-drawn graphite portraits and personal narratives created from memories shared by family and friends.

By bringing these portraits and stories into communities, schools, and public spaces, we put a human face on addiction. Our goal is to encourage learning, spark honest conversations, and reduce the shame and judgment that too often surround this disease.

A Legacy That Endures

The portraits and stories in INTO LIGHT exhibitions are more than works of art. They help others better understand addiction by showing the real lives, relationships, and experiences behind this disease. Each story adds to a larger conversation about addiction, loss, and the need for greater compassion and awareness.

Through our partnership with the McClure Archives and University Museum at University of Central Missouri, these portraits and stories are preserved as part of a permanent archive. This allows your loved one's story to continue making an impact by helping researchers, educators, and future generations learn from the experiences of real individuals and families.

The exhibition is limited to **30 submissions**, accepted beginning **August 1, 2026** on a first-come, first-served basis. Submissions close **November 1, 2026**, or sooner, when all spots are filled. There is never a fee to submit or be included in the project.
